IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ENTERING QUILTS

1. **Pre-registration is necessary.** Registration forms (which may be downloaded from our website - www.celebrationofquilts.com or completed online) must be received by **Sunday, April 29, 2018**. Printed forms are also available through YQG members. Please contact Paula Shamoian by email at pisham374@msn.com or by phone at (717) 885-0410 if you would like to pick up or be sent a registration form.

Cost for Quilt Entries: \$6.00 for first judged entry, \$3.00 if quilt is not to be judged and \$3.00 for each additional entry (display or judged).

2. **Registration Forms** must be completed and either submitted online through our website or by mail to Registrar: Cheryl Dawson, 393 Waters Road, York, PA 17403. At the time of registration, please send the completed registration forms and a **non-refundable** fee of \$6.00 for the first judged entry and \$3.00 for each additional judged or 'display' entry. You may copy the second page of the registration form to enter more items.

Be sure to **submit a photo of your quilted item online by emailing: celebratequiltsphotos@gmail.com or by mailing to the above Registrar. Include your name, quilt category, title, and size **on the back of photo** or in the message of the email when attaching your digital photo.

3. **The number of entries in each category will not be restricted.** However, judged entries must have been made by the exhibitor(s) and completed in the last 5 years. Entries must not have been judged in previous YQG shows. An entry will be critiqued but not considered for an award if it is entered in the incorrect category.

4. **A 4-inch rod pocket MUST be attached** to the top reverse side of each quilt for hanging. Clothing, miniatures, and other 'non-hanging' items do not require sleeves.

5. **All entries must have a cloth label** securely sewn to the back of the quilt with name, address, and phone number clearly printed. As one looks at the back of the quilt, position the label in the lower right corner. Other items need to have a label attached in an insignificant location. Please **cover your name** on the label with tape or fabric.

6. All entries must be clean and free of odor. The Verification Committee reserves the right to refuse to exhibit any entry deemed inappropriate, that cannot be appropriately displayed, or to display only a portion of the quilt.

7. **Quilts should be personally delivered** to York College of Pennsylvania Grumbacher Sport and Fitness Center (enter YCP campus only at 899 South Richland Ave, York, PA 17403) at the WEST entrance between 2PM and 8PM on Tuesday, May 15, 2018. ****Note:** Exhibitors who plan to mail their entries should contact Jill Coleman by phone at (717) 677-9332 or by email at: aquilter16@hotmail.com .

8. **Entries must be picked up** between 5:30 PM and 7 PM on Saturday, May 19, 2018, by again entering the WEST entrance of Grumbacher Sport and Fitness Center. **Your receipt must be presented** before your entry will be released. Quilts entered by mail will be returned by mail, postmarked no later than Wednesday, May 23, 2018.

9. First, second, third, and honorable mention ribbons per category will be awarded at the discretion of the judge(s) on Thursday, May 19, 2016 and their decisions will be final.

	HAND QUILTING EXCELLENCE	\$50 and a rosette
	HOME MACHINE QUILTING EXCELLENCE	\$50 and a rosette
	LONG ARM MACHINE QUILTING EXCELLENCE	\$50 and a rosette
	JUDGE'S CHOICE (one per judge)	\$50 and a rosette
	PEOPLE'S CHOICE	\$50 and a rosette

10. **Quilts will be accepted for sale.** If you are interested in selling your quilt, indicate it and the price on the registration form. The York Quilters' Guild will retain a 15% commission on each sale.

11. Security will be provided through York College of Pennsylvania. They provide an alarm system and onsite monitoring throughout the week of our show.

12. Exhibitors are strongly encouraged to insure their own quilted items as York Quilters' Guild and York College of Pennsylvania are not responsible for any loss, damage, or theft of any entry.

13. Your registration receipt will allow you **free admission** to one day of the show.

14. The PEOPLE'S CHOICE award will be presented at 4PM on Saturday, May 19, 2018.

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CATEGORIES

Please read carefully before selecting the appropriate category of your quilt.

If the top of your quilt was made by 1 person and it was quilted by another person, it is considered a Collaborative quilt. If you used 'found' blocks" - for example, blocks embroidered or pieced that you purchased at an auction or flea market or that you found in a family member's attic - that you used in your quilt, then you have a Collaborative quilt. **If you have any questions regarding the category of your quilt, please contact Jill Coleman by phone: (717) 677-9332 or by email: aquilter16@hotmail.com.**

JUDGED CATEGORIES:

LARGE QUILT - Is larger than 300 inches total perimeter**.

- A1 Pieced*
- A2 Appliquéd*
- A3 Mixed/Other Techniques*

SMALL QUILT - Is 300 inches or less total perimeter**.

- B1 Pieced*
- B2 Appliquéd*
- B3 Mixed/Other Techniques*

COLLABORATIVE LARGE - Made by 2 people, larger than 300 inches total perimeter**.

- C1 Pieced*
- C2 Appliquéd*
- C3 Mixed/Other Techniques*

COLLABORATIVE SMALL - Made by 2 people, 300 inches or less total perimeter**.

- D1 Pieced*
- D2 Appliquéd*
- D3 Mixed/Other Techniques*

TEAM - Made by 3 or more persons, any size or style is acceptable.

- E1 Pieced*
- E2 Appliquéd*
- E3 Mixed/Other Techniques*

MINIATURE - *Represents a full-sized pattern* and is 96 inches or less total perimeter**.

- F1 Pieced*
- F2 Appliquéd*
- F3 Mixed/Other Technique*

MISCELLANEOUS

- G1 Wearable Art- Any wearable garment with patchwork and/or quilting. List type of garment in description.
- G2 Any other quilted item - Including totes, pillows, quilted craftworks, dolls, etc. List type of item in description. Also, for dolls, the doll body and clothing must be made by the entrant.

YOUTH

- H1 Any quilted item made by someone 14 years of age or younger – judged.
- H2 Any quilted item made by someone between the ages of 14 and 18 – judged.

NON-JUDGED CATEGORY:

DISPLAY ONLY -

- N1 Any quilted item - May include contemporary or Antique items.

***Pieced** - Predominate technique more than 50% of item.

***Appliquéd** - Predominate technique more than 50% of item

***Mixed Techniques** - Combination of techniques may include embroidery, trapunto, cross stitch, stencil, etc.

****Perimeter** = Add measurement (in inches) of top + bottom + both sides

When bringing the quilt for registration, please remove all rods, hangers, or other hanging devices.
