IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ENTERING QUILTS

1. **Pre-registration is necessary.** Registration forms (available on website: www.celebrationofquilts.com) Registration form must be completed on our website or by mail to Registrar and received by **Saturday, May 4, 2024**. Printed forms are also available through York Quilting Guild members. Cost: \$6.00 for first judged entry, \$3.00 if quilt is non-judged and \$3.00 for each additional entry (display or judged).

2. **The number of entries in each category is not restricted.** However, judged entries must have been made by the exhibitor(s) and completed in the last 5 years. Entries must NOT have been judged in a previous York Quilters Guild Show. An entry will be critiqued but not considered for an award, if it is entered in an incorrect category.

3. **A 4-inch rod pocket MUST be attached** to the top reverse side of each quilt for hanging. Clothing, miniatures, and other ‘non-hanging’ items do not require sleeves.

4. **All entries** must have a **cloth label** securely sewn to the back of the quilt with name, address, and phone number clearly printed. As one looks at the back of the quilt, position the label in the lower right corner. Other items need to have a label attached in an insignificant location. Please **cover your name** on the label with tape or fabric. Entries must be clean and free of odor. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse to exhibit any entry deemed inappropriate, that cannot be appropriately displayed or to display only a portion of the quilt. Security will be provided through York College of Pennsylvania. They provide an alarm system and onsite monitoring throughout the week of our show. Exhibitors are strongly encouraged to insure their own quilted items as neither York Quilters Guild nor York College of Pennsylvania may be held liable for any loss, damage, or theft of any entry.

5. **Quilts should be personally delivered** to York College of Pennsylvania Grumbacher Sport and Fitness Center (enter YCP campus only at 899 South Richland Ave, York, PA 17403) WEST entrance between **3:00 PM and 6:30 PM on Tuesday, June 4, 2024 and picked up between 5:30 PM and 7:00 PM on Saturday, June 8, 2024. Must have receipt!**

6. **Quilts will be accepted for sale.** If you are interested in selling your quilt, indicate it and the price on the registration form. The York Quilters’ Guild will retain a 20% commission on each sale.

First, Second, Third and Honorable Mention ribbons will be awarded at the discretion of the judge(s)
Special Ribbons along with \$50 will be awarded for: Best Traditional, Best use of Color, Best Modern, Hand Quilting Excellence, Home Machine Quilting Excellence, Long Arm Machine Quilting Excellence, Judges Choice, People’s Choice and \$100 for Best of Show. Their decisions will be final!

Categories may have changed from previous show(s). Please read carefully before selecting the appropriate category for your quilt. If your quilt has a mix of quilting, enter it in the category which reflects 50% or more of the type of quilting. JUDGED CATEGORIES:

HAND QUILTED – Throw, lap, bed or etc.

- A1 Large – 300” or more perimeter
- A2 Small – Less than 300” perimeter

Please remove all rods, hangers, or other hangs devices.

HOME STATIONARY* MACHINE QUILTED – Throw, lap, bed or etc.

- B1 Large – 300” or more perimeter - with an edge to edge*** quilting design (all over design)
- B2 Small – Less than 300” perimeter – with an edge to edge*** quilting design (all over design)
- B3 Large – 300” or more perimeters- with a custom*** quilted design (a collection of quilting stitches)
- B4 Small – Less than 300” perimeter – with a custom*** quilted design (a collection of quilting stitches)

MOVABLE MACHINE QUILTED (HAND GUIDED) - Throw, lap, bed or etc.**

- C1 Large – 300” or more perimeter - with an edge to edge*** quilting design (all over design)
- C2 Small – Less than 300” perimeter – with an edge to edge*** quilting design (all over design)
- C3 Large – 300” or more perimeter - with a custom quilted*** design (a collection of quilting stitches)
- C4 Small – Less than 300” perimeter – with a custom quilted*** design (a collection of quilting stitches)

COMPUTER-GUIDED MACHINE QUILTED (50% or more of the quilt was programed) – Throw, lap, bed or etc.

- D1 Large – 300” or more perimeter - with an edge to edge*** quilting design (all over design)
- D2 Small – Less than 300” perimeter – with an edge to edge*** quilting design (all over design)
- D3 Large – 300” or more perimeter - with a custom quilted*** design (a collection of quilting stitches)
- D4 Small – Less than 300” perimeter – with a custom quilted*** design (a collection of quilting stitches)

WALL ART – INTENDED FOR WALL DÉCOR ONLY

- E1 Large – 150” or more perimeter
- E2 Small – Less than 150” perimeter

MINIATURE – MUST BE A SMALL VERSION OF A FULLSIZE QUILT - 96 inches or less total perimeter

- F1 Miniature Quilt

GROUP QUILTS – ex. BLOCK EXCHANGE, ROUND ROBINS. (must be made or quilted by a group)

- G1 Group Quilt

MISCELLANEOUS – Wearable or any other quilted items (totes, pillows, tree skirts, quilted crafts, etc.)

- H1 Miscellaneous

YOUTH QUILTER

- I1 Any quilted item made by someone 14 years of age or younger – judged.
- I2 Any quilted item made by someone between the ages of 15 - 18 – judged.

York Quilters Guild Member Only (You may choose if you want your quilt judged)

- CH1 York Quilters Guild Member Only Challenge – An Important Year in your Life!
- M1 York Quilters Guild Member Only – Mystery Quilt

(Entry fee will be waived for any challenge or Mystery Quilt not judged.)

NON-JUDGED CATEGORY:

DISPLAY ONLY –

- N1 Any quilted item - May include contemporary or Antique items.

Perimeter = Add measurement (in inches) of top + bottom + both sides

*Stationary Machine - any machine that allows the quilter to move the fabric rather than the machine and sits on a table.

**Movable Quilting Machine - any machine that allows the quilter to move the machine head rather than the fabric and is usually mounted on a frame. (longarm, mid-arm or quilting frame system for your domestic machine)

*** Edge to edge quilting means a pattern that is repeated from one edge of the quilt to the other. (same pattern overall of the quilt) Custom quilted is a collection of assorted designs throughout the quilt. Your Long Arm Quilter could provide this info.
